CHILDREN'S SAFETY IN AN EMERGENCY

1. If you hear the Crew Alert Signal, which is THE CONTINUOUS SOUNDING OF SHIP'S ALARM, and your children are in the Children's Centre or at a Youth activity, please proceed straight away to Children's Centre and collect them. If this signal is sounded while you are attending an organised youth event with your children, they will be handed back to your care. At this stage there is no further action required from yourself. Teenagers aged 13 and over will be sent back to their cabins if they are comfortable to leave. Otherwise, they will remain supervised by the Youth Staff.

2. If you hear the General Emergency Alarm, which is SEVEN OR MORE BLASTS FOLLOWED BY ONE LONGBLAST ON THE SHIP'S ALARMS, and you have not collected your children then please proceed to your allocated muster station and report to one of the Passenger Muster Personnel. They will then facilitate reuniting with your children.

3. In unlikely event that it is necessary to Abandon Ship and you have not yet reunited with your children they will be evacuated and looked after by the Youth Staff until you can be reunited.
